The scholarships will be evaluated on the following four criteria:

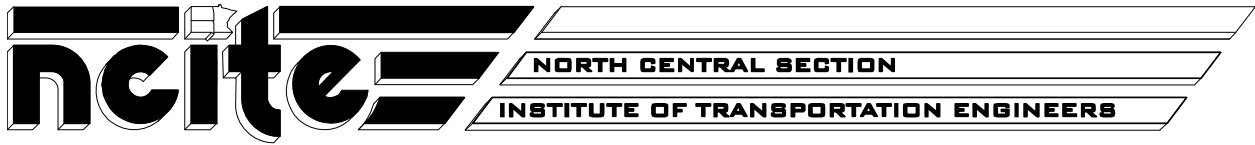
- 1.) Academic Achievement (0-5 points)
